DILIS GO DEO: Guided prayer in Daily Life in St Patrick's Strandhill This retreat takes place during the course of one's ordinary working week. It involves coming to an Opening Meeting on Sun December 1st at 8:00pm and a closing Meeting Sat Dec 7th at 3:00pm. On the weekdays in between, each person agrees to pray each day for 30 min on a given passage of Scripture, and a one to one chat about the prayer with the Prayer Guide for 20 to 30 minutes each day and is arranged at a time that is mutually suitable. This week has proved to be very popular since it was introduced into Ireland and has opened a whole new way of praying in a personal way. No previous experience of praying with scripture is necessary.
